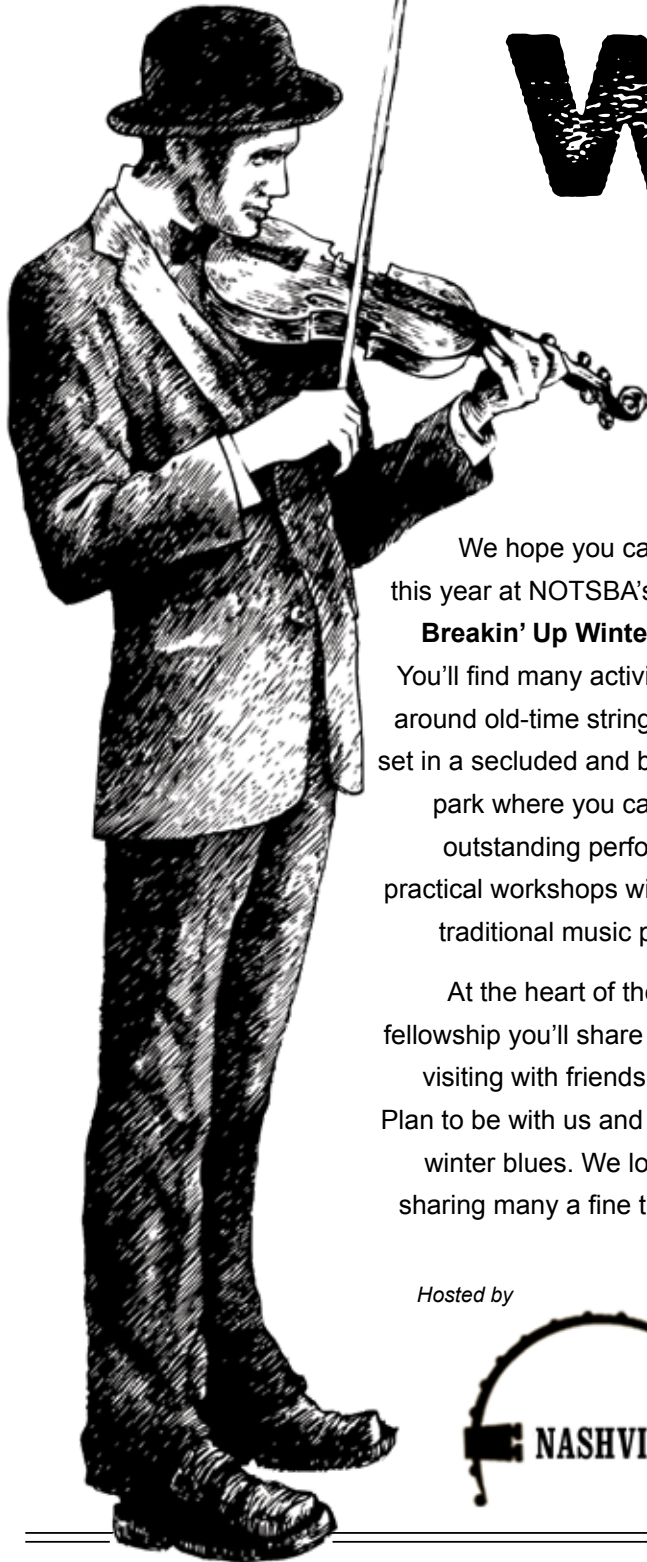

Fiddlin' Banjo Billy is from the Ozark Mountains where he's famous for his vast repertoire of old time tunes. A traditional Ozark stylist, he's bringing his band, **The Old Time Players**.

Eagleville native and acclaimed old-time buck dancer, **Thomas Maupin** recently received a 2017 National Heritage Fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts, and will present a dance workshop for us. His award-winning grandson **Daniel Rothwell** accompanies on clawhammer.

Martin Fisher has been collecting early recordings and recording devices since childhood. He will demonstrate and record music on wax cylinders, an annual treat at BUW.

Roby Cogswell will again serve as our event's emcee.

Rick Fretter will lead our Sunday Morning singalong again. He is a multi-instrumentalist well-versed in hymn, shape note, old-time and other traditional singing genres.

LOCATION

Cedars of Lebanon State Park, Lebanon, 30 miles east of Nashville.

LODGING

Cabins: There are few cabins available and many who want them, so NOTSBA holds a drawing to level the playing field. Each cabin has two double bed bedrooms and a twin bed in the loft. Kitchens are complete with cookware. All linens included. The drawing has a January 12th deadline; we email results to applicants right away. If you don't initially get a cabin, we can either destroy your check or keep you on the waiting list. Includes Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.

Group Lodge: Reserve a bunk in the Group Lodge early; its two big sleeping rooms - one for night owls, one for early birds - fill up quickly. Bunks are assigned and rooms are not gender specific (bathrooms and showers are). Bring bedding and towels. **Earplugs are recommended!**

Camping: RV and tent camping are available. Call the Cedars of Lebanon park office at 615-443-2769 to reserve your spot.

Local Motels: Lebanon, TN, 7 miles north of the park, has several motels. The EconoLodge and the Holiday Inn Express & Suites are also nearby.

FOOD

Nashville's **Mad Platter** folks will prepare a delicious spread for us, but requires a prepaid meal ticket which now includes Friday LUNCH through Sunday BRUNCH. Deadline for meal tickets: Feb. 16, 2018.
