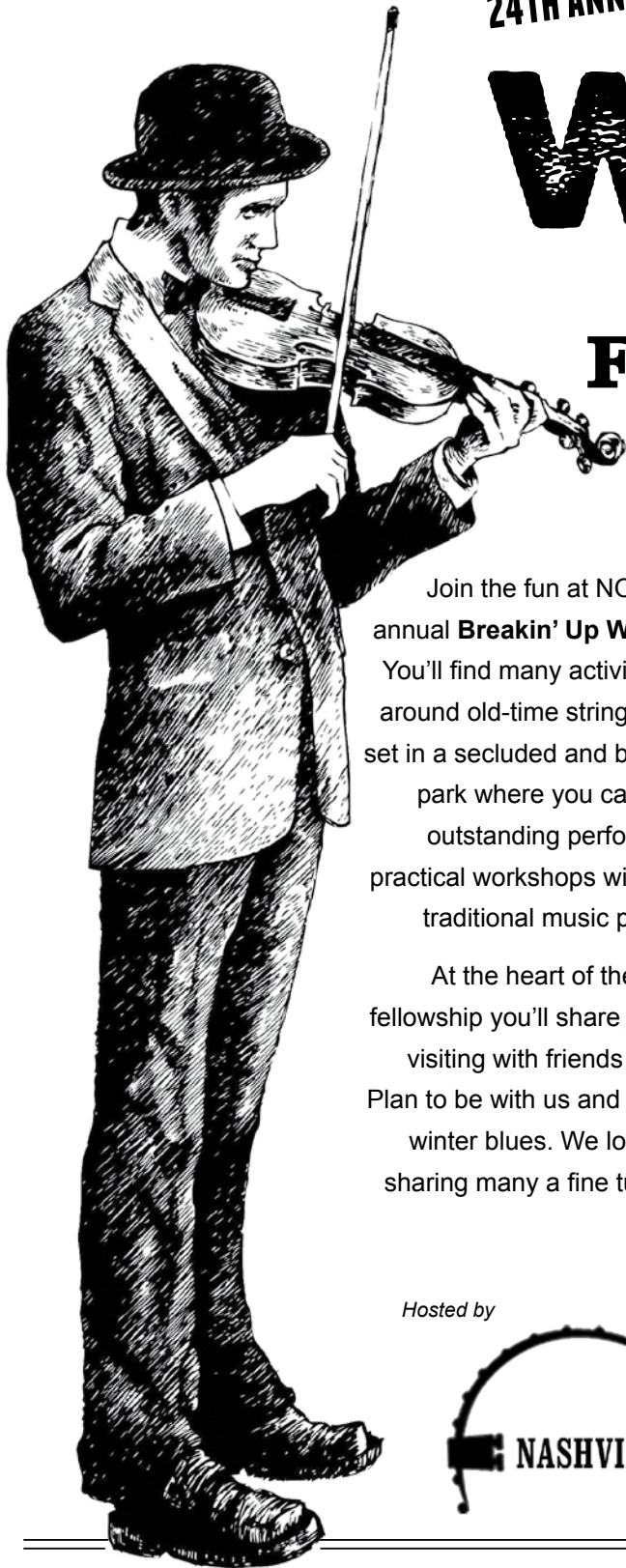

2019 PRESENTERS & PERFORMERS

Art Rosenbaum

In addition to playing and teaching five-string banjo, **Art Rosenbaum's** massive collection of field recordings are archived at the Library of Congress. He won a Grammy for Best Historical Album for his project *Art of Field Recording Volume I: Fifty Years of Traditional American Music*. He has penned four music instruction books as well. Outside the traditional music community, Art is best known as a painter, muralist, and illustrator. He taught art at the University of Georgia from 1976 to 2006, and was named the recipient of the Governor of Georgia's Award in the Humanities in 2003.

Rachel Eddy

From the rolling hills of West Virginia, **Rachel Eddy** teaches old-time fiddle, banjo, guitar and bass at music schools and old-time camps around the world. Rachel was with us in 2018 where she completely knocked everyone's socks off. You do NOT want to miss her workshops... mark your calendar today. And plan to take home one of her excellent CDs.

Charlie & Nancy Hartness

The Hartnesses are old-time players and teachers from North Georgia. Charlie's specialties are fiddle, harmonica and ukulele – and songwriting; Nancy accompanies. The two make hilarious magic together. Charlie and Nancy have one album, *Hawk Proof Rooster: Got A Little Home*, and have appeared on two Spencer and Rains recordings as well.

Jim & Joyce Cauthen

Jim and Joyce Cauthen are old-time players, teachers and advocates. Jim is a popular dance fiddler with Joyce on guitar, dulcimer, bass or banjo. She's founder of the Birmingham Country Dance Society and Director Emeritus of the Alabama Folklife Association. In 2011 the Alabama State Council on the Arts honored Joyce with a Governor's Arts Award.

Wax Cylinder Recordings

Martin Fisher has been collecting early recordings and recording devices since childhood. He will demonstrate and record music on wax cylinders on Friday after lunch, an annual treat at BUW.

LOCATION

Cedars of Lebanon State Park, Lebanon, 30 miles east of Nashville.

LODGING

Cabins: There are few cabins available and many who want them, so NOTSBA holds a drawing to level the playing field. Each cabin has two double bed bedrooms plus a twin bed in the loft. Kitchens are complete with cookware; all linens included. Our drawing has a January 11th deadline; we email results to applicants right away. If you don't initially get a cabin, we can either destroy your \$475 check or keep you on the waiting list. Includes Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. Everyone staying in your cabin must be registered for the event.

Group Lodge: Reserve a bunk in the Group Lodge early; its two big sleeping rooms - one for night owls, one for early birds - fill up quickly. Bunks are not pre-assigned and rooms are not gender specific (bathrooms and showers are). Bring bedding, towels and earplugs.

Camping: RV and tent camping are available. Call the Cedars of Lebanon park office at 615-443-2769 to reserve your spot.

Local Motels: Lebanon, TN, 7 miles north of the park, has several motels. EconoLodge and Holiday Inn Express & Suites are nearby.

FOOD

Nashville's **Mad Platter** folks will prepare a delicious spread for us, but requires a prepaid meal ticket which includes FRIDAY LUNCH through SUNDAY BRUNCH. Deadline for meal ticket purchase: Feb. 14, 2019. A food truck will be on premises for single meals.
